Activities

This training is required for Scoutmasters, Varsity Team Coaches, Venturing Advisors and their assistants. This training is highly recommended for Webelos Leaders, and it is an optional requirement for a Webelos Leader if you are working on your Den Leader Training Award knot.

Working as patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Specifics this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Scout Teams, in order to be considered "trained".

It is recommended that you wear your Official Boy Scout uniform. This is an Outdoor Training. Please bring a mess kit.

You will be required to furnish your own tent as you will be camping at the Group Campsites at Camp Pioneer. Cracker Barrel on Friday night, breakfast and lunch on Saturday will be provided.
