What should you do prior to the retreat:

- Purchase a workbook at the Scout Store or online for your faith. We have mentioned some of the books you can use. Depending on your faith.
- Make sure that your local religious institution will honor the workbook being used. Some programs require specific people to be counselors others require a signature of the religious leader.

What should you do after the retreat:

- Complete all items in the workbook.
- Get all signatures and fill out the information on the last pages of the workbook to turn in.
- Depending on the local religious institution, medals or emblems are purchased by the institution or the family members. An order form for the PRAY program is available in the back of every book. The website is www.praypub.org
- Please work with your religious institution to present the award in meaningful ceremony at there location. Scout Sunday in February is a good place or use your religious leaders discretion.

Special instructions for boys and girls of the Catholic Faith:

- Completed and filled out forms need to be turned in to the Diocese of El Paso by the first or second week of January with payment for the religious emblem.
- A special Mass will be held for all boys that completed the workbook. The diocese will contact you on the date, time, and location.

Special instructions for cub scouts:

- All cub scouts after successful completion will receive a blue knot patch for their uniform at the next pack award meeting purchased by their pack. This patch along with Arrow of Light are the only patches a Cub Scout carries over to Boy Scouts.
