- What is it?** Mescalero District Day Camp is a 3 day camp for Cub Scouts entering Kindergarten-5th grade during the next school year. Siblings are welcome to attend as long as their parent is a volunteer. Each day will provide a fun opportunity for your scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** **Join us on this year's Fantastic Adventure:** sports, sling shots, bows and arrows, learn about nature, scout skills, arts & crafts, sing songs, work on rank advancement and Cub Scout pins, play games and make new friends!
- When & Where?** Tuesday, June 26th till Thursday, June 28th, 2018 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm at H. R. Moye Elementary School, 4825 Alps, El Paso, TX 79904.
- Supervision?** **Each Pack is required to provide a minimum of one adult for every 4 youth registered to attend; this requirement can be met by either a Full-Time Volunteer/Den Leader, in addition to other volunteer staff members.** Packs may have a different leader each day, but they must be trained and must be a full-time volunteer. All Volunteers must be registered with BSA, have current Youth Protection Training, and attend a volunteer orientation training.
- Cost?** **Early Registration is \$40 per scout/siblings until May 12th.**

- Insurance?** Liability as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Yucca Council.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available, but registration may be transferred to another Scout. (for this event only).
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** for us to provide adequate program materials to all participants.

1. No Registrations will be accepted without Personal health medical record form, Part A and B. Forms can be download at www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx
2. All volunteers must attend a Day Camp orientation and turn in their Personal health medical form. Make sure Youth Protection Training is current. Weather Hazards Training must be completed (online), certificate can be turned in at orientation.
3. Refunds are not available, but registration may be transferred to another Scout (for this event only). All communication about camp will be done by email, please make sure you write your email legibly.
4. All volunteers, cub scouts, and boy scouts must be registered to participate in camp.
5. **All Junior Staff must be registered in a Scout unit. It is preferred that an adult from that unit also be a volunteer, but if that is not possible, it is expected for the Junior Staff to adhere to the Scout Oath and Scout Law.**

Camp Procedure/Rules

1. Everyone must wear the provided Camp T-shirt every day.
2. Camp is run by volunteers so please drop off your scout no earlier than **8:30am** or pick him up no later than **3:00 pm**. (Please advise Camp Director who is going to pick up the youth).
3. All volunteers must arrive no later than 7:30 am and may not leave until all youth have been signed out that day.
4. **Lunch is not provided**. Everyone must bring their own healthy lunch and snack.
5. Due to El Paso's heat in June, we will ensure that everyone drinks plenty of water throughout the day. It is recommended that campers bring a sturdy container, with the camper's name, that can be refilled with water. Please do not send soft drinks or any other sugary beverages, beverages such as Capri Sun, Kool Aid, and sodas, these drinks increase dehydration.
6. Everyone is highly encouraged to wear sun screen and a hat.
7. Participants are not to bring knives, water pistols, electronic toys, or any other disruptive items to camp. Bullying, foul language, or anyone exposing themselves will not be tolerated. Campers/adults who violate any of these rules will be subject to disciplinary action that may include, but no limited to, their removal from camp and placement in an appropriate disciplinary alternative setting and/or removal from program. Unauthorized items will be confiscated by an adult and returned at the end of the day.
8. No running in camp except for organized activities. Campers may NOT climb fences, trees, etc. and will NOT remove, discard, or relocate rocks, twigs, sticks, or other items found on the ground. Campers are NOT to throw objects unless it is part of an organized activity. Campers are to leave any stray or dead animals alone and will notify an Adult Leader.
9. The Buddy System will be implemented and followed at all times. The Buddy system is that two campers/adults will accompany each other on trips to the bathroom, first aid station, or anywhere at the camp. The Buddy System will be followed by everyone.
10. All visitors must sign in at the registration desk and receive a pass before proceeding into camp.
11. Absolutely no sandals or open toe shoes, tank tops or short shorts. Dress code will be strictly enforced.
12. Label all belongings brought to camp, i.e. hats, backpacks, lunch bags, water bottles, etc.
13. No smoking of any kind is allowed.
